Double Open End Wrenches: Which End is Up? Version 1.1

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I own a few of these double open-end wrenches. The good news is that each wrench has two sizes so I need half as many. The bad news is that there is a 50% probability that I will attempt to use the wrong end while focusing on the task at hand.



My solution is to stretch an O-ring over one end. This ring is tight enough to not freely slide over the raised logo in the center of the tool. The end with the ring nearby is the one that I do not want.

It only takes a second to slide the O-ring to the other side.
