

# String Trimmer Modification, version 1

I own two string trimmers. Both seem to be fully functional except that the line does not EVER feed correctly. Either the line does not come off the bobbin or it all comes off. I have carefully read and studied the directions numerous times and also reasoned how the mechanism should work in hopes of figuring this out. Ultimately, I have decided that it flat out does not work for me. My solution involves a very simple modification: throw the damn bobbin and cover away!



The line on the bobbin was a rather thin .065" diameter. I have replaced it with 0.90" line. The picture says the rest.

To replace the line, simply reach in and pull from the center. Then thread in a pre-tied length of new line. KISS.
